







Self-reflection, when we are yet ready to face the divine.





The symbol of the arabesque geometric motif is a symbol of knowledge in the creation of nature: the laws of mathematics and science that maintain balance, the golden ratio, the dynamics of the motion of the planets that are always moving but never competing. 


